

Welcome to your new recycling chutes

As part of the refurbishments being carried out we are introducing recycling facilities in our high rise apartments.

This means that we are making it easier for you to recycle.

We are making these changes to reduce the amount of rubbish we send to landfill, which is costing Salford City Council millions of pounds each year, and has less impact on the environment.

To help make it as easy as possible for you to recycle, each apartment has three bins in the kitchen.

These can be used to store your recyclables in before taking them to the chute. If you do not have these bins please contact Pendleton Together.



What this means for you...

You will be able to sort out your rubbish, bin it in one of three small bins in your apartment and deposit it down the recycling chute located in the corridor.

Your 3 step guide to recycling

Sort it!



In your apartment there are three bins for you to separate your rubbish.

These are for:

- paper/cardboard
- glass/plastic/cans
- non-recyclable waste

Bin it!



Put non-recyclable waste in a tied bin liner and recyclables directly into the bin.

When your bin gets full carry it from your apartment to the recycling chute located in the corridor.

Chute it!



On each floor there are two chutes. One for paper/cardboard and non-recyclable waste and one for glass/plastic/tin and non-recyclable waste.
