### **28 Day Notice of Enabling Works**

As part of the programme of works, PTOL Site team will be undertaking the enabling works to Hornbeam Court and Whitebeam Court.

The enabling works are what needs to be done to make the building ready for the new cladding system to be fitted to your block.

Below is a breakdown of the enabling works that will start 28/06/2021 and take around 31 weeks.

- Removal and replacement of Cementitious board.
- Removal and replacement of Brick work.
- Fixings to window pods and balconies.
- Installation of structures to secure the cladding behind the brick work and boards.

This will be followed by:

The re-installation of the insulation and cladding in due course.
